


Completing the Champlain Canalway Trail




REGIONWIDE
Establish links with regional snowmobile trail network.

COMSTOCK
The approximately two-mile Lock 11 Road between Route 22 and Ryder Road is being looked into as a possible on-street trail connector segment.

CANAL CORPORATION
6 miles of new trail along the west shore of the current Champlain Canal between Lock 9 in Kingsbury and Clay Hill Road in Fort Ann is planned and funded. Construction to begin in 2016-17.

SNOWMOBILERS
10 miles of Champlain Canal used by snowmobilers.

SARATOGA
A 0.6-mile segment of the trail between Wilbur Road and the town line was constructed by the Town of Saratoga along the Old Champlain Canal in 2008.

NYS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
Route 4 - including shoulders - was paved in 2013-2014 from Coveville to Route 32.

STILLWATER
The Town received CFA grant awards in 2014 to construct a new 1-mile trail segment from the existing trail at the end of the Town of Saratoga line to the existing National Park Service trail segment.

SARATOGA NHP
0.6 miles of turf trail on old towpath

STILLWATER
1 mile of existing trail, Mitchell Road to Gurba Drive. The Town has received CFA grant awards in 2013 to extend the trail further south toward Mechanicville.

Efforts are underway to secure a corridor to extend the 9-mile Zim Smith Trail eastward from its current terminus to connect with the CCT near Mechanicville.

HALFMOON
Over 2 miles of trail completed since 2008. A new 0.4-mile extension to the Waterford town line is funded for construction in 2015.

Funding has been obtained through the Scenic Byways Program for the design of important Champlain Canalway Trail linkages in Waterford and Halfmoon.

GREENWICH AND FORT EDWARD
Passed Resolutions designating River Road, County Routes 70 and 113 as signed on-street Champlain Canalway Trail connectors.

DIX BRIDGE - SARATOGA AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES
Rehabilitation of Dix Bridge as a Hudson River crossing for pedestrians, cyclists and snowmobilers was completed in 2013.

SCHUYLerville
Towns of Northumberland and Saratoga have completed the construction of a one mile trail segment along the Old Champlain Canal from Lock 5 to Route 29.

OLD CHAMPLAIN CANAL
The Town of Saratoga has received a federal grant through the Public Lands Access Program to construct a 2-mile portion of the trail along the old Champlain Canal from the Schuyler House to Garsey Lane. Ownership of one mile of the proposed trail segment has been acquired by the Town of Saratoga. Acquisition of the remaining one mile segment by the National Park Service is in progress.

SARATOGA AND STILLWATER
Passed resolutions designating River Road as a signed on-street Champlain Canalway Trail connector.

SARATOGA COUNTY
Has obtained a trail easement over the old Champlain Canal in Waterford from the end of the existing trail at old Lock 5 to the Halfmoon town line.

WATERFORD
2.5 miles of existing trail along the old Champlain Canal.

COHOES
Developed a link between the Erie Canalway Trail and Champlain Canalway Trail - 2013-2014.
